ESCRICK

You may have spotted our team working along Carr Lane this week as we've now recommenced the network build. We've now commenced a four-week civils programme allowing us to build and repair the required infrastructure. Overlapping this, at the end of October, we'll commence installing the fibre cables with the vision of completing the network before the end of this year.

Cabinet status

On Monday, October 2 our meter was installed into the cabinet by a third-party supplier. Now this has been completed, we have made arrangements with our provider for the leased line to be connected. This is the vital fibre connection between Escrick's cabinet and the local internet exchange. Until this is installed, we cannot begin home installations.
